- 1 Apologies for absence received from Tim Dokchitser, Andrew Lobb, Sarah Rees, Alexander Stasisinski, Lynne Walling and Stuart White.
- 2 Minutes of the AGM of BMC 2014, held at Queen Mary University of London, were approved, with no matters arising.
- 3 BMC 2016, University of Bristol. On behalf of the organisers, Tim Browning reported that the 2016 BMC would be held at the University of Bristol from 21-24 March 2016. The Public speakers are to be Kristin Lauter (Microsoft, President of Assoc. for Women in Math.) and Hendrik Lenstra (U Leiden) and Plenary Speakers are to be Alex Lubotzky (Hebrew U, Jerusalem; Algebra) Luigi Ambrosio (Scuola Normale Superiore, Pisa; Analysis) Robert Adler (Technion, Haifa; Probability) Amie Wilkinson (U Chicago; Ergodic theory) Maria Chudnovsky (U Columbia, New York; Combinatorics) Peter Sarnak (Princeton U; Number Theory). Workshops are to be held in Algebra, Analysis, Combinatorics, Ergodic Theory, Number Theory, Probability.
